Art exhibit "Seed Stories" opens in San Juan del Sur

The opening of Gwendolyn Beachy's art exhibit, April 12th, in the Galería del Sur (http://www.piedrasyolas.com/whatsnew_eng.htm#galeria_del_sur) was a resounding success. The project was financed by the Jean Brugger Foundation. More than 100 people attended to enjoy wine, cheese, and great paintings. Gwendolyn sold 4 paintings in the first 5 minutes and 11 in total.

"I felt just so wonderful that so many people came and supported me and bought my art."

Local people and a group of doctors from Louisiana visited the show. There was a bidding war over one painting. The woman who bought it said it is the first piece of artwork going into her new house, her old house having been destroyed by a hurricane.

Gwendolyn, who drove to San Juan in 2007 from New Mexico in a school bus with a cat, a dog, and a crazy-looking boyfriend, recalls the only one who wasn't stressed out about the adventurous move was the cat.

She also says her real passion is sculpting: "It started four years ago. I had the idea of creating beautiful images of vulvas. I see it as a way to make people more comfortable with female sexuality. I want to celebrate me being a female. Sculpting is very sensual and sexual. Watercolour is different. It doesn't have the same effect. It is a more like drawing a cartoon, to get a good laugh about it."

Gwendolyn is starting a new series focused on butterflies. Hopefully she will have another show within the year with new work.

The current show is open until April 20th. Some pieces will go to the local bookstore Gato Negro (<http://www.elgatonegronica.com/>); some will go to the restaurant El Colibri afterwards.

Also, Gwendolyn will start teaching drawing and watercolour classes, offered through Pelican Eyes: http://www.piedrasyolas.com/brugger_eng.htm, twice a week, at the Galeria.
